Dear Mr. Smathers:

This letter requests a 10 day extension as it relates to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Office of Intelligence and Analysis (I&A), dated 30 September, 2011. You are seeking the following documents:

“Copies of all regular reports between 1/1/2011 and 9/30/2011, made by the person responsible for the DHS priority “threat of radicalization and extremism. The reports may be for their direct supervisor, a board, Congress, Committees, etc.”

Due to the increasing number of FOIA requests received by this office, we may encounter some delay in processing your request. Per Section 5.5(a) of the DHS FOIA regulations, 6 C.F.R. Part 5, the Department processes FOIA requests according to their order of receipt. Although DHS’ goal is to respond within 20 business days of receipt of your request, the FOIA does permit a 10-day extension of this time period. As your request seeks numerous documents that will necessitate a thorough and wide-ranging search, DHS will invoke a 10-day extension for your request, as allowed by Title 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(B). Responsive records to your request were received in this office today. The volume of records to review and process is quite extensive but every effort will be made to complete your request in less than the 10 days allowed by Title 5 § 552(a)(6)(B).
